Origin of the event

This Conference is the final event of the project “MEET – Meeting the health literacy needs of immigrant populations” consistent with the objectives of the Programme of Education and Training 2020 for the promotion of new forms of health literacy.

MEET Project co-ordinated by Oxfam Italia, was developed in collaboration with Centre for the Advancement of Research & Development in Educational Technology - CARDET, Nicosia; Istituto Superiore di Sanità; Verein Multikulturell/Multicultural Association, Innsbruck; Polibienestar Research Institute – University of Valencia; Research Innovation and Transformation - RITA, University of Leed, London.

The European partners will present the results of the project focused on migration and health particularly about the following subjects: alcohol consumption, mental illness diseases, mother and child health, HIV/AIDS and voluntary interruption of pregnancy.

Goal and objectives
